## 2014 Truck Raffle Rules

These Official Contest Rules may not be waived, modified, or supplemented except by the Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation. No modification of these official contest rules shall be enforceable unless made by the Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation.

<b>1<sup>st</sup> Prize</b>	<b>1967 Dodge Power Wagon 4x4 Grass Fire Truck, approx. 6,500 miles</b>
<b>2<sup>ND</sup> Prize</b>	Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) Cash
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Prize</b>	Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) Cash
<b>Drawing Date</b>	<b>February 15, 2015 or October 18, 2015</b> Drawing will be held on the 2/15/15 if all 1,000 tickets are sold.
<b>Ticket price</b>	<b>Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) each</b> A total of one thousand (1,000) tickets will be sold
<b>Stipulation</b>	A minimum of eight hundred (800) tickets must be sold in order for the truck to be awarded as first prize. If less than eight hundred (800) tickets are sold, 1 <sup>st</sup> prize will revert to fifty percent (50%) of the total amount collected in ticket sales. <b>Winner need not be present to win.</b>

The raffle drawing shall be held at the Grafton Township Hall in Grafton Township, Ohio. All tickets must be received by the drawing date to be eligible for the drawing.

Each ticket will be entered separately in the drawing. Each ticket is a separate and equal chance to win a specified prize.

Winner has thirty (30) days to take delivery of the 1967 Dodge truck located in Grafton Township, Ohio, or forfeit all claims thereto. To pick up the vehicle, two forms of identification, one of which must be a photo ID will be required to prove that this person is the person on the winning ticket.

Due to postal regulations, raffle ticket stubs cannot be returned by mail for purchases over the internet, through the mail or by telephone. When an order is placed, we will complete the ticket by filling in the name, address, and phone number, and we will drop the ticket in the barrel at the Grafton Township Hall. At the drawing, the winner will be contacted based on the name and information on the ticket. Purchasers do not need their ticket stubs for any reason. However, the stubs will be kept on file at the Grafton Township Hall.

If not present, winner notification will be made by telephone or mail.

Tickets are generally sold in numerical sequence. Various foundation members taking orders may have batches of tickets, and in this case, tickets may be sold out of order. Requests for specific ticket numbers will not be accommodated.

Participant must be at least eighteen (18) years old. Winner may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility at the discretion of the Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation.

Winner is solely responsible for all taxes, registration, title, transfer fees, license duties, insurance and all expenses in claiming, registering and using the truck. This may include sales taxes and property taxes.

# Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation 2014 Truck Raffle Rules

The Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation has no liability with regard to taxes and fees for the vehicle.

In the event the truck was lost, damaged, destroyed, or otherwise not available, Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation's liability shall be limited to refund of ticket price to participants. Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation's liability for any other claim is limited to refund of ticket prices.

Winner agrees to the use of his/her name, address, photograph or videotape likeness and statements for publicity purposes by Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation, and agrees to sign a publicity release without any further compensation.

Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation reserves the right to cancel this contest at any time, in which event its liability is limited to refund of ticket prices to participants.

Ticket sales to Grafton Township Fire & EMS Foundation members will be prohibited.

Any person who engages in conduct designed to corrupt the outcome of a charitable gaming activity with the purpose to defraud, or knowing that he is facilitating a fraud, is guilty of a Class D felony.
